

SHIFT ELECTRICIAN SUGAR MILL

Applications are called for a suitably qualified tradesperson for the position of "Shift Electrician" in our modern, well regarded sugar mill.

The Mill operates on a continuous basis seven days per week during the "crushing season", and the position will involve shift work, rotating on a 4 shift roster including night, day and afternoon shifts (40 hour week). During the maintenance season the successful applicant will work day work on a 4 day week (9 hour day) basis carrying out maintenance or capital works as required.

Location:

Qualifications:
